Questions from Bidders	Answers from the Commission
<p><u>Question 1</u> The "Instructions to bidders - Other Documents to be submitted with the Quotation" state that "Bidders shall include a copy of the bidder's registration documents/license(s)". Please advise what is meant with registration documents/license(s).</p>	<p><u>Answer 1</u> This refers to the official registration of your company with your local authorities or licenses to operate as a company e.g. certificate of incorporation, license to operate in a particular sector, as applicable, VAT registration, etc.</p>
<p><u>Question 2</u> The "Instructions to bidders" include Sample of Price Schedule. Since the Terms of Reference state that forward modelling should be applied to different geophysical techniques, are bidders expected to provide separate quantities and quotes for each of the geophysical techniques?</p>	<p><u>Answer 2</u> Yes, the Quotation should clearly breakdown separately all quantities and applicable cost items (specify the unit rates proposed) for each of the requirements in the Terms of Reference e.g. each geophysical technique and the overall, aggregated amount but it is up to the bidder to decide on the lay-out of the Quotation. The Sample of Price Schedule is only included as a guideline and it is not mandatory to use it.</p>
<p><u>Question 3</u> Please advise if the Commission expects separate reports for each, individual forwarding modelling or if the results should all be described and discussed in a single final report.</p>	<p><u>Answer 3</u> Please refer to Section 2.1.2 and Section 3 of the Terms of Reference.</p>
