Item#	QUESTION	ANSWER
1	We would be interested in responding but our structure does not allow us to address the 24/7 constraint requested in the TOR. Is this a strict constraint?	 24/7 availability requirement is primarily for rare, critical situations. The contractor shall be able to respond within 24 hours to serious issues in the operational pipeline that fall under the contractor's responsibility. This response time is necessary during normal working days, from Monday to Friday. The Commission has its own operational unit that typically handles all operational incidents. The contractor's involvement is only required in the rare case that the Commission's team is unable to identify or resolve the issue, or if the problem is determined to be within the scope of the contractor, including official holidays, is to cover the unlikely event that such an issue
		arises over a weekend or holiday. Although these incidents are rare, they could have a significant operational impact if not addressed promptly.
