#### TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

#### ROUGH TERRAIN ELECTRIC PALLET TRUCK

#### 1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Preparatory Commission for the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty Organization with its headquarters in Vienna (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") is the international organization mandated to establish the global verification system foreseen under the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty (CTBT), which is the Treaty banning any nuclear weapon test explosion or any other nuclear explosions. The Treaty provides for a global verification regime, including a network of 321 stations worldwide, a communication system, an International Data Centre and On-site Inspections (OSI) to monitor compliance with the Treaty. More information can be found on the Commission's website: www.ctbto.org.

After entry into force of the CTBT, an OSI might be carried out in various environmental conditions and locations worldwide with a maximum duration of up to 130 days in the field.

These operations require the setup of a Base of Operations (hereinafter referred to as "BOO"). During the setup many items such as field deployable tent infrastructure, accessories, field furniture and other related equipment with various capacities and sizes to support the operation will be moved.

Due to weight constraints many of these items cannot be hand carried.

The Commission requires a vehicle for moving equipment, capable of being operated even under rough terrain conditions (e.g. gras, gravel) to support operations during OSI activities (hereinafter referred to as the "Goods" and/or "Services").

The Contractor shall provide the Goods and Services in accordance with the requirements of these Technical Specifications and in the most cost-effective manner possible.

## 2. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

The rough terrain electric pallet truck shall meet the following technical specifications:

Load capacity: minimum 1250 kg
Lifting height: 350 - 450 mm.

Maximum pallet width: 1.200 mm.

Weight: max. 500 kg.

Driving motor: 2250 - 2750 W.

Lifting Motor: 2000 - 2500W.

Capacity of the batterie(s) 100 - 120 Ah.

Fork dimensions: 100 x 45 x 1000 mm

Adjustable fork opening: 500 - 900 mm

#### 3. WARRANTY AND OPTIONAL MAINTENANCE SUPPORT

The Contractor shall provide warranty for a warranty period of two (2) years for all equipment provided by the Contractor. The warranty shall include complete replacement of any equipment and systems provided by the Contractor, which at any time during the warranty period, due to manufacturing faults or poor workmanship does not meet at least one requirement of the present Technical Specifications.

Optional maintenance support to meet the manufacturer's warranty and maintenance requirements shall be provided as an option in the offer. Maintenance support can be provided by the Contractor as an option in order to maintain manufacturer's maintenance services and should be available to be supplied by a local dealer in Austria.

## 4. **DELIVERY TERMS**

The Equipment must be fully delivered no later than 30 April 2025.

#### **Physical Delivery:**

Delivery shall be made DAP 2020 (door-to door) to the CTBTO TeST Centre (Austrian Institute of Technology (AIT)), 2444 Seibersdorf, Austria.

It is the responsibility of the Contractor to properly deliver to the Commission without any damage and in full accordance with the Technical Specifications. The Contractor shall be liable for any damage to Equipment during its delivery.

#### **Delivery Documentation**

Upon delivery of the Equipment, the Contractor shall provide a documented list of delivered Equipment and the associated serial numbers. Operations and maintenance manuals written in the English language shall be included with the delivery of the Equipment.
